True Cross; followed by The Feast of Saint Pius X {August 21st} original name Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto, (born June 2, 1835, Riese, Venetia, Austrian Empire [now in Italy]—died on August 20, 1914 in Rome, Italy; and was canonized on May 29, 1954. Pope Pius X was an Italian pope {1903-1914} whose staunch political and religious conservatism dominated the early 20thcentury [3];

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

As per Christian tradition the <u>True Cross</u> was discovered in 326 by <u>Saint Helena</u>, the mother of the Roman Emperor <u>Constantine the Great</u>, during a <u>pilgrimage</u> she made to <u>Jerusalem</u>. The <u>Church of</u> the Holy <u>Sepulchre</u> was then built at the site of the discovery, by order of Helena and Constantine. The church was dedicated nine years later, with a portion of the cross. One-third remained in Jerusalem, one-third was brought to Rome and deposited in the Sessorian basilica Santa Croce in Gerusalemme (Holy Cross in Jerusalem), and one-third was taken to Constantinople to make the city impregnable.^[1] The date of the feast marks the dedication of the <u>Church of the Holy Sepulchre</u> in 335.^[2] This was a two-day festival: although the actual <u>consecration</u> of the church was on September 13, the cross itself was brought outside the church on September 14 so that the clergy and faithful could pray before the True Cross, and all could come forward to venerate it. 
The Memorial of St. Helena the mother of Emperor Constantine



St. Helena Empress of the Roman Empire

Helena, or **Saint Helena** (<u>Greek</u>: Άγία Ἑλένη, *Hagía Helénē*, <u>Latin</u>: *Flavia Iulia Helena Augusta*; c. 250 – c. 330), was an <u>Empress</u> of the <u>Roman Empire</u>, and mother of <u>Emperor</u> <u>Constantine the Great</u>. Born the lowest of commoners,^[1] possibly in <u>Drepana</u>, <u>Bithynia</u> in <u>Asia Minor</u>, she became the <u>consort</u> of the future <u>Roman Emperor Constantius Chlorus</u> (reigned 293–306) and the mother of the future Emperor <u>Constantine the Great</u> (reigned 306–337). Helena ranks as an important figure in the <u>history of Christianity</u> and of the world due to her influence on her son. In her final years, she made a religious tour of <u>Syria Palaestina</u> and <u>Jerusalem</u>, during which she allegedly discovered the <u>True Cross</u>. The <u>Eastern Orthodox Church</u>, <u>Oriental Orthodox Church</u>, <u>Roman</u> <u>Catholic Church</u>, and the <u>Anglican Communion</u> revere her as a <u>saint</u>; the <u>Lutheran Church</u> commemorates her.

Constantine appointed his mother Helena as <u>Augusta Imperatrix</u>, and gave her unlimited access to the imperial treasury in order to locate the relics of <u>Judeo-Christian</u> tradition. In 326-28 Helena undertook a trip to the <u>Holy Places in Palestine</u>. According to <u>Eusebius of Caesarea</u> (260/265 – 339/340), who records the details of her <u>pilgrimage</u> to <u>Palestine</u> and other eastern provinces, she was responsible for the construction or beautification of two churches,


St. Helena Empress of the Roman Empire the <u>Church of the Nativity, Bethlehem</u>, and the <u>Church</u> <u>of Eleona</u> on the <u>Mount of Olives</u>, sites of Christ's birth and ascension, respectively. Local founding legend attributes to Helena's orders the construction of a church in Egypt to identify the <u>Burning Bush</u> of Sinai. The chapel at <u>Saint Catherine's Monastery</u>—often referred to as the Chapel of Saint Helen—is dated to the year AD 330

Jerusalem was still being rebuilt following the destruction caused by Titus in AD 70. Emperor Hadrian had built during the 130s a temple over the site of Jesus's tomb near Calvary, and renamed the city Aelia Capitolina. Accounts differ concerning whether the temple was dedicated to Venus or Jupiter.^[20] According to Eusebius, "[t]here was a temple of Venus on the spot. This the queen (Helena) had destroyed."^[21] According to tradition, Helena ordered the temple torn down and, according to the legend that arose at the end of the 4th century, chose a site to begin excavating, which led to the recovery of three different crosses. The legend is recounted in Ambrose, On the Death of Theodosius (died 395) and at length in <u>Rufinus</u>' chapters appended to his translation into Latin of Eusebius' Ecclesiastical History, the main body of which does not mention the event.^[C] Then, Rufinus relates, the empress refused to be swayed by anything short of solid proof and performed a test. Possibly through Bishop Macarius of Jerusalem, she had a woman who was near death brought from the city. When the woman touched the first and second crosses, her condition did not change, but when she touched the third and final cross she suddenly recovered, ^[d] and Helena declared the cross with which the woman had been touched to be the True Cross.



The convent of <u>Sant'Onofrio al Gianicolo</u> contains the official church of the order.

<u>Sant'Onofrio</u> al <u>Gianicolo</u> is a <u>titular church</u> in <u>Trastevere</u>, <u>Rome</u>. It is the official church of the papal <u>order of knighthood</u> <u>Order of the Holy Sepulchre</u>. A side chapel is dedicated specifically to the Order and a former grand master, <u>Nicola Canali</u> is entombed there.




